GARDENS - incl. FURNITURE ALLOWANCE		
The College will provide a new Tutor with an allowance of up to £3,000 to buy furniture for one room of the house, which will be used exclusively for business reasons, ie to meet with parents. Receipts for such furniture will need to be given to the Estates Bursar and the furniture will be the property of the College. If appropriate, and at the end of the Tutor's tenure in Social, the College may transfer the furniture to the Tutor to keep.		
REMOVAL EXPENSES		
When a Tutor moves into a Social, the College will provide an allowance of up to £2,000 against removal costs, other furnishings, etc. Receipts must be retained and passed to the Bursary to support claims in respect of this allowance.		
At the end of his/her term as a Tutor, the College will reimburse removal expenses (the lowest of three quotes) for relocating within the campus.
