### **Match Day Arrangements**

We will make every effort to publish all teams on **SOCS** the evening before scheduled matches. Please bear with us, however, if injuries and late adjustments to selection mean that teams change. If you have any doubt as to which team your son might be in or where and when he is playing, please check with him. For home matches, there is a map of the Radley pitches outside the Round Pavilion which should help you find your son's team, or ask any member of Radley staff to help direct you. Parking is limited this year due to the building project at the heart of campus; please use Kennington Gate and the Golf Club car parks. Everybody is welcome to support matches. Please do so in the right way, and show the warmth of Radley's hospitality to visiting parents, guests and match officials. Parents' match teas will be in the Round Pavilion. Boys may not attend this match tea in sports' kit, so if you wish to see your son while he is in kit, please go to the Coffee Shop. You are welcome to bring dogs on to campus but please clear up after them using the bins provided, and keep dogs on the lead whilst on the pitches on match days; there is a footpath loop around Little Wood (at the far end of the pitches) should you wish to exercise them further. No dogs are allowed in the Round Pavilion. Radley is a no-smoking campus (even out on the pitches); all visitors should adhere to this. We hope that you will enjoy watching your sons play matches over the year.

We are always delighted to see parents supporting fixtures. You will have noticed that work has started on the extension and refurbishment of the Music School. As such, car parking spaces have decreased around the College.
